Being a key driver of a fast growing metropolitan statistical area (or MSA) of almost a half a million people, immediately adjacent to the largest military installation in the world we are lucky to boast a bevy of resources that support a large diverse economy.

Each month, 500 troops exit Fort Hood to enter the civilian labor pool, creating steady, proven, dependable source of labor and skills to support any business operation in Central Texas. These individuals provide a skilled workforce pipeline unlike any other in the US. The Copperas Cove EDC will work with you to customize direct labor programming to fit your needs.



The newly shielded Interstate 14 (I-14) begins in Copperas Cove and is currently being extended to reach markets to the west and east. We are an hour north of one of the fastest growing cities in the Country (Austin) and within four hours drive time of over 20 million people (DFW, Houston and San Antonio).



The largest multi-modal facility (or inland port) is currently being developed in part by the EDC and BNSF Railway to support growing distribution and logistical needs of our multi-faceted economy. This project will create the first inland port between DFW and San Antonio and economical market opportunities for companies looking to invest in Central Texas.

The EDC manages one business and industrial park immediately adjacent to I-14 (with another on the way) and we have every tool and economic development incentive that we will use to support your growth in Central Texas.


Dining, Recreation, & After Hours Fun






All City parks are open from 5:00 am - 11:00 pm, unless special hours are approved by the Parks & Recreation Department. For reservations of facilities, a special event/facility rental application must be submitted. Deposits are due at the time of reservation in order to secure the facility. All rental fees are due 14 days prior to the event. If the rental is being made within the 14 days, then all of the rental fees are due at time of reservation. Wander Through one of the City's Parks

Copperas Cove has eight public parks for community and visitors to enjoy. City Park Complex is 88 acres, and home to 2 ponds, 2 basketball courts, 2 playscapes, 6 baseball/softball fields, 3 multipurpose fields, and the City Park Pool! Parks and Recreation also holds the City's Annual Food Truck Festival, Fall-O-Ween Festival, Easter Egg Roundup, Fishing in the Park and 5K Run to the Polar Bear Plunge at their beautiful parks. South Park features a mile-long walking trail, as well as a splash pad, pool, pavilion and playscape. Other parks include beautiful scenery and playgrounds for you to enjoy.



Work on Your Back Swing

The Hills of Cove Golf Course is an 18-hole facility owned and operated by the City of Copperas Cove. The original nine hole golf course was built in 1972, but was expanded to 18 holes in 1999. The course, a par 71, winds it way through the rolling terrain of northeast Copperas Cove and is made up of five challenging Par 3s, nine magnificent Par 4s, and four exuberant Par 5s. The Hills of Cove offers on-site golf professionals, golf lessons, a full-service pro shop, beer sales, driving range, grill, and a fleet of 40 golf carts. So, whether you want to play a quiet round of golf with friends, enjoy a great lunch, or set up a tournament, Hills of Cove Golf Course can take care of your needs.




