

2022 Rabbit Fest Parade Rules

* Parade rules will be strictly enforced*

- Single vehicle entries must be decorated.
- The person in charge of the float must remain with that float throughout the parade and must have a cell phone on his/her person. This person and cell phone number must be indicated on the parade registration form. Any changes must be reported to the parade Chair prior to the parade.
- Participants must maintain a forward motion at all times once the parade has begun. No stopping or lagging behind will be allowed.
- For any cars or car clubs that are entered in the parade: **Burning rubber or excessive acceleration will absolutely not be tolerated. Violators will be removed from the parade immediately.**
- No one may leave the parade until it has reached the dispersal area at Cove Terrace Shopping Center.
- In the interest of public safety, nothing may be thrown to spectators directly from floats or other vehicles (This includes candy. Candy can be handed out by *parade walkers*). Children tend to run into the path of the float.
- Participants in parade must refrain from smoking and the consumption of alcoholic beverages.
- Parade participants driving their own vehicles must submit proof of liability insurance with their registration form.
- During lineup at the staging area, all entries must be equipped with the following:
 - *Fire extinguishers *A working horn
 - *Proof of insurance *Working lights on any/all vehicles
- Share the spirit of the season with spectators and fellow parade participants.
- Participants must exit floats at the dispersal point. Due to safety concerns and a city ordinance – NO ONE may ride floats back to the high school.
- Categories will be judged for best in theme, best float, and best in each category.
