On behalf of the Alaska Chamber, I am writing to express our support for the Alaska Energy Authority's (AEA) United States Department of Energy competitive grant application (DE-FOA-0002197) to provide critical coordination and technical support needed to implement the State of Alaska Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Network and Fleet Adoption project.
