Tricia Montgomery earned her Ph.D. from Florida State University in 2004. After graduation, she worked at the Florida Center for Reading Research (FCRR) as the Coordinator of Assessment Programs where she trained educators in the early reading assessment and progress monitoring component of Florida's Reading First initiative. Later, she became the Assistant Director for Assessment Programs where she was charged with overseeing the development of an online resource demonstrating the use of assessment data to drive instruction.

For the past ten years, she has been on faculty at Florida State University in the School of Communication Science and Disorders, where she serves as the Director of Clinical Education, and the Graduate Program Director for Distance Learning. She has developed and taught face-to-face, hybrid, and fully online courses. She teaches courses in FSU's Main Campus Undergraduate and Graduate programs as well as in their Distance Learning (DL) Masters and BRIDGE programs. She has previously served as a member of the CAPCSD Conference Planning Committee.
