This year's event will be all virtual/online. Photographs of your entry/entries can be uploaded beginning at 11:00 p.m., Friday, November 6th through 11:00 p.m. November 12th. Log on to artsinthealley.gcchamber.org, complete the application, pay the entry fee, and upload a picture of your entry. If entering more than 1 item, each item entered will require separate applications and payments. If you have any questions or need additional information, please call Patty Estadt at 614- 477-1522.

Rules:

1. Quilt entries must have been completed since 2017.
 2. Limit 4 quilts per person.
 3. Please respect copyrights & give credit to any design sources.
 4. No quilt previously entered in the Arts in the Alley Quilt Show will be accepted.
- *Quilts entered in the virtual show this year will be allowed entry in the live show in 2021.*
5. For 2020, the Duet and Solo machine category have been combined.

The entrant should have made the quilt top. The quilting may have been done by another.

Categories:

- Hand quilted – Pieced or Applique or Embroidered, any size
- Pieced and machine quilted – Large (bed quilt)
- Pieced and machine quilted – Small (wall hanging or lap)
- Applique or mixed techniques (embroidery, whole cloth, etc.) – Large (bed quilt)
- Applique or mixed techniques (embroidery, whole cloth, etc.) – Small (wall hanging or lap)
- Youth up to 18 yrs.

Judging Criteria:

Quilts are evaluated based on both visual Impact and workmanship. Visual impact is created by the choice of color, fabric, design and composition. Workmanship includes the construction, quilting and finishing techniques. For 2020 judging will be based on the photos you submit. Category winners will be determined by the online voting for People's Choice in each category. Voting will take place from November 14- November 29 at noon.

Judging and Awards:

Best of Show/People's Choice Highest Vote Award Winner: \$50

1st place: \$25, 2nd Place: \$10, 3rd place: Ribbon, Honorable Mention: Ribbon
