This year's event will be all virtual/online. Photographs of your entry/entries can be uploaded beginning at 11:00 p.m., Friday, November 6th through 11:00 p.m. November 12th. Log on to artsinthealley.gcchamber.org, complete the application, pay the entry fee, and upload a picture of your entry. If entering more than 1 item, each item entered will require separate applications and payments. Entry Fee:

\$8 per entry. No limit on number of entries. However, no previous entries will be accepted.
Entries into this year's Virtual Arts in the Alley can also be entered in 2021.

Categories: (Each piece can be entered into only one category)

- Needle Art - 2 Classes:
 - Class 1 - Includes Knitting, Crochet, Weaving, Fashion / Fabric
 - Class 2 - Includes Cross Stitch, Needlepoint, Embroidery, Ribbon Embroidery
- Decorating: Includes Floral, Home Décor, Seasonal
- Painting: Includes China, Ceramics, Tole
- Wood - Small: Includes Hand Carved Originals, Wall Hangings, Accessories, Bird Houses
- Wood - Large: Clocks, Furniture, Chests
- All Other Crafts: Includes Clay, Dolls, Jewelry / Beading, Paper Craft, Leather, Stained Glass

The selected category for each entry will be reviewed by the Show Chair. If the wrong category was selected, it will be moved to the correct category.

Entries made from kits will not be accepted.

Judging:

Entries will not be judged but winners will be determined by People's Choice voting.
People's Choice voting begins on November 14 and ends November 29th at noon.

Awards:

Best of Show: \$100.00, **1st place:** \$50.00 and ribbon, **2nd place:** \$25.00 and ribbon, **3rd place:** Ribbon

NOTE: In the event that an insufficient number of entries preclude reasonable competition in any category, the Craft Show Committee reserves the right to reduce the number of prizes awarded.
