Commercial Property Taxes	Advance innovative solutions to decrease the commercial property tax burden
Parking Supply, Access & Cost	<ul> <li>Increase the number of available slots for Downtown businesses</li> <li>Reform the parking slot allocation system to meet the needs of small business employees, customers and Rochester visitors</li> <li>Ensure consistency and fairness in slot allocation</li> <li>Align timing on parking meters to fit the needs of small business customers</li> </ul>
Government Fees	Oppose significant increases in government license and permit fees on small business
Street & Sidewalk Improvement Districts	Oppose the creation of Street & Sidewalk Improvement Districts which will charge all property owners, including non-profits, in a district a fee to pay for new sidewalks or sidewalk improvements without an assessment hearing
Planning Process	Advocate for improved efficiency and a reduction in time for the planning process and approval

Monitor Transit Oriented Development (TOD)/Land Development Manual (LDM)	Ensure the TOD and LDM process drives economic growth and do not adversely impact small businesses
North Broadway	Ensure the City moves forward with the approved design plan, and assessments are based on the special benefit analysis
Placement and Activation of Transit Hubs	Ensure transit hubs are placed and activated in a way to optimize community & economic development
Highway 52	Support state funding for continued upgrades and improvements of this important highway
