## ROADMAP TO ENDING THE EMERGENCY ORDERS ON BUSINESS RESTRICTIONS

### THE STATE OF BUSINESS

Because Minnesotans care deeply about supporting their local businesses, vaccines are being deployed statewide. Hospitalizations and positivity rates are very low, so now we must deploy a plan that gives businesses time to reopen to normal capacities. Businesses have worked hard insuring preparedness plans are in place.

TODAY

Bars and restaurants can open at 75% capacity, indoor and outdoor dining. Food and beverage service must stop at 11pm.

Parties of no more than ten people must remain six feet from other parties; bar seating is open to parties of two.

Indoor and outdoor events (including weddings) can be at 50% while maintaining seating distance and closing at 10pm. Max 100 persons for social events.

Hair salons open at 75% capacity.

Offices may allow employees to return to work if they choose to.

Hotel pools, gyms and fitness centers can open up to 50% capacity with no masks required during exercise. 9ft spacing requirements.

1 Million Vaccines Deployed

30 - 45 DAYS

Restaurants open at 100%. Bar seating returns to normal. Events open to 75% and/or 250 people max capacity. 10pm curfew moves to midnight for restaurants and events

Hair salons open at 100% capacity.

Movie theaters open at 75% capacity.

Gyms and fitness centers open to 75%. Hotel and public pools open to 75% with spacing still urged.

2 Million Vaccines Deployed

MAY 1

In keeping with signage and business practices, we remove final business restrictions, businesses may open at 100% while still encouraging washing, wearing, and spacing.

Events are open at 100% capacity, 1am - 2am closing is permitted.

\*\* If at anytime a surge reappears and changes are needed to this plan, the Governor and the LCC must gather and decide together any new restrictions. The LCC will meet weekly (or bi-weekly) until June 1st. They can together watch emerging trends, concerns or advance business openings more quickly when 4 or 5 agree.

7 day positivity rate under 6% throughout duration of plan.
