FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When is BonAire?

BonAire takes place on Saturday, June 11, from 9am-10pm.

Where is BonAire taking place?

What is the cost?

All BonAire events are free and open to the public.

Where should I park?

Can I bring a chair?

Yes, you are welcome to bring a camping chair and make yourself comfortable at any of our venues.

What food options are available?

There are dozens of restaurant and take-out options in downtown, on Shore Road, in Perkins Cove, and on Route 1. A food truck will be parked in the music venue, and a sandwich shop in Jacobs Lot will be selling food and snacks outside the restaurant. Food options are more limited at the family activities at the playground, so it may be wise to plan ahead and bring some snacks and drinks for your kids.

Am I allowed to bring alcohol?

NO. Public consumption of alcohol is against the law in Maine.

Are there public restrooms available?

Yes, there are many options. There is a public restroom in Jacobs Lot adjacent to the music venue and craft fair. There are also public restrooms at Main Beach, in the Dunaway Center adjacent to the family-friendly activities in the playground, and at the far end of Perkins Cove.

What happens if it rains?

BonAire is a rain or shine event, so please plan to dress accordingly.
