FIRE PROTECTION SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT MILLAGE PROPOSAL

Shall the tax limitation imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in the Township of Onondaga, Ingham County, Michigan, be increased by 1 mill (\$1 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for six (6) years, 2023 through 2028 inclusive, for the purpose of providing fire protection services and equipment, raising an estimated \$78,000.00 in 2023.

OPERATING MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy the statutory rate of not to exceed 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance and renews millage that will expire with the 2023 tax levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 17.8669 mills (\$17.8669 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Eaton Rapids Public Schools, Eaton and Ingham Counties, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 10 years, 2024 to 2033, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2024 is approximately \$1,804,424 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2023 tax levy)?
