WILLIAMSTON COMMUNITY SCHOOLS MILLAGE RENEWAL PROPOSAL TO PROVIDE FUNDS TO OPERATE A SYSTEM OF PUBLIC RECREATION AND PLAYGROUNDS

This proposal will allow the school district to continue to levy public recreation millage previously approved by the electors that will expire with the 2023 levy.

Shall the currently authorized millage rate limitation of 0.7321 mill (\$0.7321 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property in Williamston Community Schools, Ingham County, Michigan, be renewed for a period of 10 years, 2024 to 2033, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for operating a system of public recreation and playgrounds; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect for such recreation program if the millage is approved and levied in 2024 is approximately \$362,000 (this is a renewal of millage that will expire with the 2023 tax levy)?

Fowlerville District Library

Library Millage Renewal Proposal

Shall the Fowlerville District Library, County of Livingston, be authorized to levy annually an amount not to exceed .9419 mill (\$0.9419 for each \$1,000 of taxable value), which is a renewal of the previously authorized millage rate that expired in 2021, against all taxable property within the Fowlerville District Library district for a period of ten (10) years, 2022 to 2031, inclusive, for the purpose of providing funds for all district library purposes authorized by law? The estimate of the revenue the Fowlerville District Library will collect in the first year of levy (2022) if the millage is approved and levied by the Library is approximately \$632,000.
