- 3.) Each act is limited to a maximum of 5 minutes. This will include set up, performance, & breakdown.
- 4.) All contestants must arrive and be ready to perform at 7:15pm on Saturday, Sept 17th. Contestants arriving late may be disqualified.
- 5.) Contestants will be judged based on talent, originality, dress/costume/character, audience interaction and overall appeal.
- 6.) Contestants must not have engaged in any activity which, by community standards, could be characterized dishonest, immoral, indecent, or in bad taste. No previous criminal convictions.
