Welcome to the Limitless Youth Leadership Forum

It takes great courage to face and overcome the challenges and trials of being a foster child. Being removed from your family is painful enough but surviving in insecure environments while in constant transition can be an overwhelming process.

Coupled with the upheavals of adolescence and statistics that work against them, many foster youth chart a perilous journey through to adulthood – often completely alone. In choosing to take part in the Limitless Youth Leadership Forum, you're showing our community's young people transitioning from foster care the power of a community that cares, connects and equips them as overcomers, bringing hope for a brighter tomorrow.

Care and Support for Foster Youth Transitioning from Care to Adulthood

The Limitless Youth Leadership Forum is designed for high-school aged foster youth who are facing an imminent transition out of the foster care system. Many of these young people suffer with isolation, anxiety and depression developed after years of adversity; and they lack important life skills, safe connections and basic resources. Through hands-on learning opportunities, youth will discover their interests, build relationship and career skills, and develop connections to resources and community leaders that can assist them as they transition into adulthood. A Limitless Youth Scholarship Fund will be established to help qualified youth address barriers to wellbeing, education, housing and career opportunities.

Embracing and Empowering Foster Youth

With the participation of certified educators, mental health professionals, leading foster care agencies and nonprofit partners, business, faith leaders, and civic, state and county leaders, the one-day program helps youth come to realize their limitless worth and the vast network of caring, safe people and reliable resources they can access for support at a critical time in their lives. They also learn that the brokenness in their home lives was not their fault and despite extreme adversity, they can choose to be overcomers by developing healthy and permanent relationships with caring adults, building new skills, and accessing reliable resources and opportunities available to them to ensure their well-being and success. In the process, youth discover that they're not alone, they have limitless capacities, and that other young people face the same challenges and have overcome to achieve their dreams and lead happy, connected and fulfilling lives.

The hands-on learning sessions include:

- ▶ Personality styles
- ▶ Communication skills
- ▶ Resume, dress for success, interviewing and landing the job
- ▶ Discovering your passion: career tracks
- ▶ Leadership 101
- ▶ Speed Networking
- ▶ Mentoring as a pathway to success
- ▶ Lunch with Corona Police & Fire and other community leaders

Investing in Tomorrow's Leaders

By fostering collaboration between agencies working with foster youth, the 2021 Forum aims to inspire an annual event to invest in foster youth – our communities' future leaders. Additionally, each participant in the 2021 Forum will have the opportunity to suggest a younger participant that they can support over the next year, accompanying to a potential 2022 Limitless Youth Forum proposed to target middle-school aged foster children.
