Introduction and Team Building: Team Building Activates may include *True Colors*, a low-ropes course, educational speaker, class project or other activities to uniquely unite each class.

Education: Tours/discussions with Southeast Missouri State University, Sikeston Campus, Three Rivers College, and Sikeston Career and Technology Center

Industrial Development: Tours/presentations by Orgill, Unilever, DeWitt Company, Alan Wire Company.

City Government: Opportunities may include a private meeting with the mayor and/or city councilmen, presentation by Sikeston BMU and tour of the Sikeston Power Plant.

Healthcare: Tours/discussions with Missouri Delta Medical Center, Ferguson Medical Group, and Kenny Rogers Children's Center.

Hometown Heroes: This new session for the class of 2018 allowed participants the opportunity to talk directly with a variety of community leaders, including business owners, past city officials and others who have been essential to our community.

Agriculture and Agri-Business: Tours include Monsanto, Pioneer, SEMO/New Madrid Port Authority, a local farmer, and often ends with a celebration at a local winery.
