## Examples of sessions:

<u>Introduction and Team Building:</u> Introduction to the program, expectation, class project overview. Team Building may include *True Colors* or educational speaker.

<u>Education:</u> Divided among the different sessions, tours include with Southeast Missouri State University, Sikeston Campus, Three Rivers College, and Sikeston Public Schools.

<u>Industrial Development:</u> Tours/presentations by a combination of the following: Unilever, Alan Wire Company, Tetra Pak, Refresco, Steward Steel, or Do It Best, Sikeston Economic Development.

<u>City Government:</u> Tour of Department of Public Safety. Presentation by the City Manager. Tour of Public Works Dept (Streets, Parks, Airport). Meeting with elected City Leadership. Presentation at the Sikeston BMU and tour of the Sikeston Power Plant or Water Treatment facility.

<u>Healthcare:</u> Tours/discussions with local healthcare providers such as Missouri Delta Medical Center, Ferguson Medical Group, Semo Health Network, Kenny Rogers Children's Center and more.

<u>Hometown Heroes:</u> This new session allows participants the opportunity to talk directly with a variety of community leaders, including business owners, past city officials and others who have been essential to our community.

<u>Agriculture and Agri-Business:</u> Tours/presentation by a combination of the following: Greenway Equipment, SEMO Port Authority, local farmer/farm family, Apple Ridge Orchard, Seed Tech. and often ends with a celebration at River Ridge Winery.
