


Homestead Parklands is on the northern half of Perch Lake, which is the central feature of the park. The land area includes steep slopes covered by oak woodlands and pine trees.

Glen Hills Park is a water-based recreation facility that consists of 700 wooded acres surrounding the beautiful 78-acre Glen





# **Park Passes:**

Vehicles entering St. Croix County Parks must display a valid park pass. The passes are sold as either a daily pass or an annual pass. Passes can be purchased at park entrance stations, the Government Center in Hudson, or at one of the pay boxes. You may also purchase an annual pass online here: parks.sccwi.gov







Troy Beach is a five-acre day use park on the St. Croix River, a National Scenic Riverway. The shaded beach offers protection from the sun on warm summer days.

The Wildwood Trail is a seven mile off-road hiking, biking, and snowmobiling trail on a former railroad right-of-way. The unpaved trail runs from the Village of Woodville south to the St. Croix / Pierce County line, through the Town of Eau Galle.




#### **APPLE RIVER PARK**




## **UNDER DEVELOPMENT**

Eckert Blufflands is along the St. Croix River and consists of 170 acres of deep ravines, over 100-foot high river bluffs, forests, and more than half a mile of river shoreline.


