

NOTICE

Road work on Kenwood Ave south of the Four Corners starting Monday, Nov 1

- Kenwood Ave south of the Four Corners (eastbound only) will be closed and traffic detoured – the westbound lane will remain open
- Delaware Ave will have a slight lane shift but no lane closures

WHY

The sewer main under Kenwood Ave was installed in 1929. A section near the Great Wall of China restaurant and the 4Corner Laundry Room is collapsing, causing dips in the road.

WHAT'S HAPPENING

We will excavate to replace the damaged section of sewer main, then will line the pipe from the Four Corners south about 300 feet to minimize the likelihood of future breaks and problems.

TRAFFIC

- <u>Delaware Ave</u>: slight lane shifts but no lane closures are projected
- Kenwood Ave north of the Four Corners: no lane shifts or closures
- Kenwood Ave south of the Four Corners: the westbound lane will remain open – the eastbound lane will be closed during construction

TIMELINE

This is a complicated project because the sewer main is deep and there are underground gas and communication lines near it.

- Start Date: Monday, Nov 1
- Projected End: Sunday, Nov 14


