#### Peoria International Airport | Convenience & Connectivity

With daily nonstop flights to four of the five most connected airports in the country, the General Wayne A. Downing Peoria International Airport (PIA) has all the amenities of a metropolitan airport, but without the congestion and hassle. Nearly 700,000 people fly through PIA every year, taking advantage of daily nonstop flights to connect to the rest of the world.

"Central Illinois knows that we're big enough to get you everywhere you need to be, but small enough to care you get there," says Director of Airports Gene Olson. "Between our free parking and shuttles, our great airline partners and staff and our connections, I believe we strike that perfect balance of convenience combined with connectivity."

PIA offers travel to 11 nonstop destinations via four airlines: American, Delta, United and Allegiant. With daily flights to five hub airports—Atlanta, Charlotte, Chicago O'Hare, Dallas/Fort Worth and Minneapolis—Peoria is better



connected than most downstate airports, and it continues to grow. PIA set a new passenger record in 2018, with 672,594 passengers traveling through the airport.

PIA offers both TSA PreCheck and its Premier Club private lounge, a rare amenity among small airports. Access to the lounge and secure parking just steps from the main terminal are available for an annual subscription. Otherwise, parking at PIA is free.

PIA also has a full-service U.S.

Customs and Border Protection facility, which handles about 200 international corporate, charter and general aviation flights each year.

Also owned and operated by the Metropolitan Airport Authority of Peoria, Mt. Hawley Airport caters to corporate pilots, with its prime location near many area businesses. Recreational pilots also benefit from Mt. Hawley, which has a courtesy vehicle for their use, a flight school and hangars for rent.



# **GOVERNMENT AFFAIRS**

The Illinois General Assembly wrapped up their work for the state's legislative session.

This session resulted in the passing of many new bills that will directly and indirectly affect our members and their customers.

- Illinois passed a \$45 billion capital investment plan that includes a gas tax increase and vehicle registration fee increases.
- The General Assembly passed a law that would make Illinois the 11th state to legalize recreational cannabis.
- The state passed a \$40,000 per year minimum wage for teachers.
- · Illinois lawmakers approved a \$40 billion budget.
- Illinois lawmakers passed a pay raise for themselves.
- In the event Illinois voters amend the constitution to allow for a graduated income tax, the General Assembly passed what the new rates would be.
- The state will now require online stores and warehouses to pay state sales tax.
- The State of Illinois will increase the cigarette tax and has opened the pathway for Chicago, Danville and downstate casinos.
- · Illinois has legalized sports betting.
- · Illinois passed an apprenticeship tax credit.
- The state extended the Research and Development Tax Credit.
- · Illinois has eliminated the franchise tax.
- The state passed a law that will require corporate boards to file annual reports on their racial, gender and ethnic make-up.


