"T. rex: The Ultimate Predator" Debuts in Peoria on its Worldwide Tour

Warning: You May Never Think of T. rex the Same Way Again!

Ferocious, feathered and for the first time on the road, "T. rex: The Ultimate Predator," presented by CEFCU, debuts on its worldwide tour at the Peoria Riverfront Museum.

This jaw-dropping new exhibition is based on the latest scientific discoveries about Tyrannosaurus rex, and comes directly from its creator, leading T. rex researcher and founder, the American Museum of Natural History (AMNH), NYC – the "Night at the Museum" museum.

Full-scale feathered models of the world's most iconic dinosaur are on display, from a hatchling that resembles a fluffy turkey poult to a feather-covered juvenile to a city-bus-sized adult T. rex with feather patches. While the mega-predator was capable of crushing prey with a 7,800-pound bite force, research finds that it was also very smart and sensitive

Designed for families and children of all ages, "T. rex: The Ultimate Predator," also features fossil casts - including AMNH 5027 (a.k.a. "Rexy"), the first full-size skeleton ever discovered - immersive interactives, a full-sized animated T. rex that "plays" with visitors, a T. rex "roar mixer," and a mesmerizing shadow theater re-creating an epic battle.

"How exciting! For the first time, Peoria is the launching point for a major international traveling exhibition tour and with one of the most popular museum subjects of all-time researched by the same museum that discovered the T. rex," said Peoria Riverfront Museum President & CEO John Morris. "Our museum members see T. rex for free!"



The museum's "Summer of T. rex" programming takes T. rex into the rest of the museum with Giant Screen Theater dinosaur films including the full "Jurassic Park" series, "Asteroids vs Dinosaurs" Dome Planetarium show, Dino Lab makers space, and much more.

Gov. Pritzker Highlights Successes in Balanced Fiscal Year 2022 Budget

Governor JB Pritzker celebrated the \$42.3 billion Fiscal Year 2022 General Funds operating budget, a responsible spending plan that is balanced, protects the state's most vulnerable Illinoisans, pays down the state's debts, and rebuilds the state stronger than ever as Illinois comes out of the pandemic.

The comprehensive bill (SB2800) approved by lawmakers contains the FY22 operating and capital budgets. The major components of the FY22 budget invest in the governor's key priorities of education, healthcare, public safety, human services, criminal justice reform and ongoing pandemic relief, while fully funding the state's pension contributions.

Illinois is expected to receive more than \$8.1 billion in federal relief through the ARPA Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund to assist the state in recovering from the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic over the next three and a half years. The state's FY22 budget allocates \$2.8 billion of the funds, including \$1 billion in capital projects, toward pandemic-recovery-related government programs, services and projects. Additional spending plans will be developed once final guidance is received from the federal government. It is expected that \$2-3 billion will be utilized to replace lost state revenues due to the pandemic and ensure continued funding of essential government services and minimal payment delays to the state's vendors.

The fiscal year 2022 capital budget, included in SB2800, represents a continuation of the historic Rebuild Illinois program and other ongoing capital initiatives, allowing the state to keep investing in projects for statewide transportation, environment, education, and

community and economic development infrastructure. The FY22 capital budget also utilizes \$1 billion in ARPA funds to prioritize critical infrastructure projects for statewide broadband and water and sewer projects. The budget will go into effect on July 1, 2021, the beginning of the state's 2022 fiscal year.

Illinois Becomes First State in Midwest to Hit President Biden's 70% Adult Vaccination Goal

Eligible Illinoisans Automatically Entered into Lottery for \$7M in Cash Prizes for Adults, \$3M Scholarships for Youth

As Illinois continues to lead the Midwest in vaccinating our residents, Governor Pritzker announced a new \$10 million 'All In for the Win' promotion that will reward vaccinated Illinoisans by automatically entering them into a series of cash and scholarship lotteries with prizes up to \$1 million.

More than 70% of Illinois adults have received at least one dose of the COVID-19 vaccine, according to the CDC, making Illinois the first state in the Midwest to reach President Biden's goal.

Illinois makes Juneteenth an official state holiday

HB3922 - The new law making June 19 a paid holiday for state employees and public school educators takes effect next year and came the same day the U.S. House voted in favor of making Juneteenth a federal holiday. However, under the Illinois law Juneteenth will be a paid holiday only if it falls on a weekday. Since Juneteenth is on Sunday next year, the first paid state holiday will be in 2023, according to Pritzker's office.

Getting Vaccinated Can Get You a Free Drink Under New Law Signed by Gov. Pritzker

SB104 - Businesses serving alcohol can now offer up a free drink to vaccinated patrons under a new law signed by Governor JB Pritzker today. The measure also extends businesses' ability to sell cocktails for pickup and delivery.


