## **Force Protection Exercise Media availability**

PENSACOLA, Fla. — Naval Air Station Pensacola will host a media availability on Tuesday, Feb. 4, at 10:00 a.m., to allow news outlets the opportunity to cover the anti-terrorism force protection exercise on the base.

Exercise Solid Curtain-Citadel Shield, an annual exercise conducted by Commander, U.S. Fleet Forces Command and Commander, Navy Installations Command on all Navy installations in the continental U.S. The exercise is designed to enhance the readiness of Navy security forces and ensures seamless interoperability among the commands, other services and agency partners. All security processes will be implemented during the exercise to evaluate preparedness.

Media will have an opportunity to obtain videography/photography of a portion the exercise where a “suspicious package” is discovered. For exercise integrity, please do not share the details prior to the training on Feb. 4.
