Ear, nose and throat doctor and facial plastic surgeon joins Ascension Sacred Heart, serving adults and children

Pensacola, Fla. (September 30, 2020) – Ear, nose and throat doctor and facial plastic surgeon Kevin Caceres, MD, has joined the Ascension Medical Group Sacred Heart regional network of doctors and will care for adults and children at his Pensacola office.

As an otolaryngologist – or ENT doctor – Dr. Caceres will treat conditions such as chronic sinus infections, nasal polyps, nasal septal perforations, hearing loss, chronic ear infections, thyroid nodules, cancers of the head and neck, voice problems and salivary gland conditions. He is fellowship trained in facial-plastic surgery, specializing in nasal obstruction, rhinoplasty, eyelid lifts, face lifts and ear pinning. He also treats children including conditions such as recurrent ear infections, enlarged tonsils, hearing loss, sleep apnea, congenital neck masses and airway problems.

Dr. Caceres will see patients from his offices on the Ascension Sacred Heart Pensacola campus. Adult patients will come to the DePaul Building at 5147 North Ninth Ave., Suite 325A. Children will visit the Pediatric Specialist Tower at 5153 N. Ninth Ave., next door to the Studer Family Children's Hospital. Dr. Caceres is accepting new patients and most major insurances. Dr. Caceres received his bachelor's degree from Rollins College in Winter Park, Florida, where he was awarded a full-tuition scholarship. He then graduated with his medical degree from Baylor College of Medicine in Houston. He completed his residency training in otorhinolaryngology - head and neck surgery - serving as chief resident, followed by a fellowship in facial plastic and reconstructive surgery at University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston.

His research has been published in multiple medical journals and he has presented at multiple national organizations' meetings including the American Laryngological Association, the Triological Society, the American Academy of Facial Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery, and the American Academy of Otolaryngology–Head and Neck Surgery.
