## Local Charity Becomes a Member of the Greater Pensacola Chamber

Their mission to educate people about the treatment and prevention of breast cancer has not changed, however, and so PBCA is finding new ways to encourage mindfulness. Partnering with the Greater Pensacola Chamber brings more opportunities to increase awareness. As a chamber member stated,

Most people are affected one way or another by this terrible disease, so we are thrilled to have them be a part of the chamber."

Local businesses are also getting involved with PBCA to advocate for Breast Cancer awareness. Just to name a few, Central Credit Union of Florida sold candy bars at each of their five locations during the entire month of October with all proceeds going to PBCA, and CrossFit VU completed their "BarbellsForBoobs" event generating money to donate to PBCA on October 24<sup>th</sup>. All My Sons Moving and Storage and Anderson Subaru are important major sponsors for the Pensacola Breast Cancer Association and make generous contributions throughout the year as well.

Since inception in 2003, the PBCA has raised and distributed approximately \$650,000 to local healthcare organizations that are consistent with their mission. Currently, any funds generated are distributed to Baptist Health Care and Sacred Heart Hospital so that they can provide free mammograms to women (and some men) who are underinsured or without insurance altogether.
