The park, located at 3100 North 12th Street, encompasses 2.47 acres in the East Hill neighborhood of Pensacola and offers a basketball court, playground equipment, and benches.

By keeping the park clean and litter-free, they are protecting not just the environment but also the children and adults who can now enjoy the common area safely.
