

GET YOUR COVID-19 VACCINATION

Baptist Health Care offers vaccine appointments when supplies are available.

Extended hours and weekend appointments have been added to accommodate work schedules. Please note that eligibility guidelines are updated frequently. Visit eBaptistHealthCare.org for the latest requirements.

Vaccines are currently available to Florida residents who are:

- Age 50 or older
- Medically vulnerable with prescribed State of Florida form that must be completed and signed by a physician. Form is available at eBaptistHealthCare.org/easyschedule.
- Health care workers*
- Preschool, K-12 school or day care employees of any age*

*If you are in one of the eligible work groups, you must present work badge or proof of employment at the time of your vaccine appointment.

Appointments are required. No walk-ins allowed.
