That's right, it's a time when we can focus our attention on the abilities and skillsets that the Deaf community brings to the work place. Effective interactions encourage teamwork, growth and inclusion. The team at GCE shares some things you may not have known:

- The more inclusive way to reference this group is to say "deaf and hard of hearing" or "deaf" instead of "hearing impaired." - When writing about the Deaf community, capitalize the term as it represents a cultural identity.
- Ask Deaf people how they prefer to communicate (i.e. interpreter, writing, sign language).and seek out an appropriate accommodation.
- When working with an interpreter, it's helpful to give time before a meeting for the interpreter and Deaf participant(s) to work through necessary logistics and set up.
- When we get to know Deaf people at work or in our communities, we enhance our own skillsets and learn of the valuable contributions they can make.
