"Bourbon Time" by Bill Carlson, *Wine Specialist*



We have had the opportunity over the years to participate in Barrel Programs or Store Picks. A Barrel Program is where the store actually plays a role in how the whiskey turns out. There are two ways

you can go about this.

The most common way to pick a barrel is for the distillery to send 4 – 8 different samples from different barrels in their rickhouse. Before Covid, you would actually go to the distillery and they would make it fun and informative before you sat down and made the pick. Today, a representative from the distillery visits you with the samples and you taste through them. Usually the account would get 4 – 6 good customers with great bourbon or rye knowledge to help make the pick. There is usually a lot of lively discussion of which barrel is best and then you vote on your pick. After the pick is made and you give it a name that goes on the label and it can take anywhere from 2 – 6 months to receive it. It's bottled for you and the yield is around 200 bottles and you get to keep the empty barrel that the whiskey was in.

The second way to get a barrel is a blending program. You are not picking a single barrel but blending it from several barrels. You typically get 3 – 5 different styles of let's say bourbon all with different mashbills. The challenge and fun is to get the blend you think tastes the best. A rep from the distillery brings beakers (like in chemistry) and this is where the mixology takes place. You blend the samples by percentages until you get the one you're happy with. It's always amazing how changing just a tiny bit of the blend creates a drastically different whiskey. We did an Angel's Envy blend several years ago and spent over two hours with their Master Distiller Wes



Henderson getting it just right and it was very successful.

Barrel Programs or Store Picks are a hot commodity today particularly in the bourbon world. The barrel or blend you pick is unique and can only be found at your store or bar. Bourbon aficionados come out of the woodwork to hunt these special bourbons down to add to their collection. This past December Seville sold a single barrel of Buffalo Trace in 48 hours!

Seville has several barrel programs hitting the store in the upcoming months. Maker's Mark Cask Strength Stave Finished and a special Heaven's Door Bourbon (6 year MGP single barrel around 120 proof) will be available in May. This month, along with the North-West Florida Barrel Pickers we will be tasting for two new barrels for Seville, Old Elk and WhistlePig. In the works are Jack Daniels Single Barrel Barrel Proof and Old Forester Cask Strength. We would love to do 10 – 15 barrels this year!

I see barrel programs continuing in popularity for years to come. It's what sets you apart from other bars or stores. The bourbon hunters want rare bourbons bottled at cask strength and this is what this program provides. Check out the Wine Shop's Facebook page, Seville Quarter Wine and Libations, so you don't miss out on the next pick.
