As a result of this year's sales the credit union was able to contribute a total of \$1,850 to three different causes focused on Women and Men's Health Awareness.

This year, the credit union made donations to the Pensacola Breast Cancer Association as a conclusion to October being National Breast Cancer Awareness month and to Hope & Health Clinic in Pensacola and St. Andrew Community Medical Center in Panama City, FL in support of November being Men's Health Awareness Month. Each of these organizations help uninsured members of the community across the Gulf Coast region receive access to free medical services and educational opportunities.
