**OWA Parks & Resort to Host a Series of Hiring Events for Indoor Water Park
Positions starting between \$13 to \$17 per hour**

(Foley, Alabama) - Tropical touches have begun to appear at the main entrance gates to *Tropic Falls*, soon to be home to the largest indoor waterpark on the Gulf Coast. OWA Parks & Resort is in the process of transforming its 14-acre amusement park, featuring 23 rides and attractions, as well as a new \$70+ million water park into a tropical paradise.
