Special-shaped balloons are always the stars of the show at ballooning events. **Laska the Unicorn** is traveling to us from Land O' Lakes, Florida, flown by Tom Warren, **Sunny Boy** is piloted by Benjamin Drennan of Cordele, Georgia, and **Humpty** is flown by Rich Lawhorn from Louisville, Kentucky.

Over 55 beautiful hot air balloons will be participating in this year's festival and at dusk and dawn, wind and weather permitting, they will be rising to fly in our South Baldwin skies for all to see. Along with balloons at dusk and dawn and balloon tethered rides (both weather permitting), there are lots of activities for everyone to enjoy at the festival throughout each day. Saturday, May 14 – 11:00 am - 10:00 pm = Festival open to the public with arts and craft vendors, children's activities, Tropic Falls at OWA., and live entertainment.
