Scholarship Description

The Home Builders Association of West Florida Tradesmen Educational Council, has a mission to honor student achievement and leadership, promote educational excellence, and enhance career opportunities for technical students. Students who apply for the honor society should demonstrate academic achievement, skills development, leadership, honesty, responsibility, and good character.

The HBA Scholarship Program is a need-based scholarship program, with awards based on financial need in addition to academic performance and personal character. Applicants must have a minimum of two years' of enrollment in a HBA Construction Academy, a trade program within your high school or *can demonstrate an interest in learning a skilled trade as a profession*. Students must be prepared to enroll in an accredited two or four-year college, university, vocational/technical, and currently hold a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Scholarships are open to graduating high school seniors. Scholarship monies will be paid directly to the educational institution in the student's name.

Student applicants must meet the following guidelines:

- 1. Plan to attend, or currently attend an accredited trade school or trade program on a full time basis.
- 2. Must have a Grade Point Average (GPA) of 2.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- 3. Must have acquired acceptance to, or be enrolled at the trade school or program of his/her choice and must be an enrolled full-time student for the summer or fall semester of 2022.

Student applicant should note any special financial needs on their application form.

All applications and supporting documents must be received no

later than April 18, 2022.

Please advise your high school records clerk of this deadline for submission of transcripts and other supporting documentation.
