The 12<sup>th</sup> Annual "Pancakes with Santa" is hosted by the Cordova Rotary Club with support from many area businesses including Barrett McClean Photography who will provide professional photography. The event will also host a holiday market in the GCKH parking lot. Proceeds of the event will benefit Gulf Coast Kid's House, a nonprofit organization that facilitates the investigation, prosecution, and treatment of child abuse and neglect and promotes child abuse prevention awareness through community education.

A pancake breakfast will be available to purchase at the event for \$5 per person. Children 3 and younger are free. Mimosas and Bloody Mary's will be available for purchase.
