ECPS Special Centers Receive DJJ's Highest Accountability Rating

Pensacola, FL - For the second consecutive year, two ECPS Special Centers affiliated with the Department of Juvenile Justice (DJJ) have received DJJ's highest accountability rating.

Escambia Boys' Base and PACE Center for Girls have both been deemed "Commendable" for the 2022-2023 school year.

The Florida Department of Education (FDOE) released 2022-2023 DJJ Accountability Ratings on Friday, May 26th.
