Since the 1970s, WSRE has been home to culinary legends and cooking show pioneers like Julia Child, Jacques Pépin and Pensacola's own Earl Peyroux. Irv Miller, executive chef at Jackson's Steakhouse in Pensacola, performed as the host chef on WSRE's "Flavors of the Coast" series in the early 2000s.
