PensaCan 2023 pushes total event contributions past 75,000-meal mark; award winners named

Pensacola, FL (October 5, 2023) – PensaCan 2023 was a success, raising the equivalent of 19,261 healthy meals for neighbors in need in Escambia and Santa Rosa counties through donations of food and funds to Manna. In total, the event has now provided more than 77,310 healthy meals to the hungry since its start in 2009!
