The theme for the activities at the Pensacola MESS Hall this month is Games. Games are a fun way to develop logical reasoning, analytical skills, and physical intuition which are fundamental to math, engineering, and science success. Visitors can try their hand at our giant games, including mancala, mill stone, and tilt tracks. Our mess kit menu features Dots to Square, Popsicle Stick Bomb, and Seashell Guess Who, as well as many other experiments to investigate scientific principles. On November 24 and 25 visitors will be able to challenge our staff to some of the games sold in our gift shop, or they can try the games with their family.

There are additional opportunities to explore this month with our extended hours. Our regular school year hours are Tuesday - Friday, 12 PM - 5 PM, and Saturday, 10 AM - 5 PM.
