- Marie Masters, a pharmacy technician, supported a family that had lost a loved one and helped one of the family members secure a Habitat Home.
- Kathy Saldana, patient experience advisor, collaborated with members of her church to create ministries to lift up and unite others.

A 14-person selection committee reviewed each nomination submitted by employee leaders and fellow team members. Votes were cast for the most compelling examples of Baptist values. Winners were recognized during Baptist's 2024 National Hospital Week celebrations.

This marks the 25th year Baptist has recognized team members as Legends. More than 224 individuals have been honored. In 2021, the entire Baptist Health Care workforce was recognized as Legends for their tremendous commitment during the pandemic to patients, the community and each other.
