COVID-19 INFORMATION

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR SUPPLY CHAIN WORKERS

If you are a supply chain worker, flight crew worker or airline employee travelling in NWT, where travel originated from an inter-jurisdictional border, you must do the following.



LESS THAN 36 HOURS IN THE NWT

- Self monitor and abide by [self-distancing rules](#) under the current NWT Public Health Order.
- Immediately self-isolate and contact health care provider if you exhibit any symptoms of COVID-19.
- Self-isolate while not working:
 - Limit your interactions with other persons as much as possible.
 - Wear a face and mask and go directly to your self-isolation location.
 - If you are being picked up in a car, taxi or other motor vehicle, sit in the backseat as far from the driver as possible.
 - Do not share a car, taxi or other motor vehicle with any person, other than the driver if necessary, who is not self-isolating in the same location with you.
 - If you have to make a long drive, only make short stops for take-out food, fuel or to use washroom facilities, if necessary, while wearing a face mask.
 - Contactless payment must be used where available.
 - Any time spent inside a store, gas station, or other similar indoor location is to be kept to a minimum.
 - Keep a 2-metre distance from other persons you will not be self-isolating with.
- If circumstances cause you to be in the NWT more than 36 hours, you **MUST** contact Protect NWT immediately to file a Worker Self-Isolation Plan.



MORE THAN 36 HOURS IN THE NWT

- Submit a Worker Self-Isolation Plan (W-SIP) to Protect NWT as soon as reasonably possible (two weeks in advance is recommended). You must follow all requirements outlined in your W-SIP.
- Self-isolate while not working. Plan to have everything you need with you for your trip.
- Self monitor and abide by [self-distancing rules](#) under the current NWT Public Health Order. When not possible wear a mask and/or use appropriate personal protective equipment.
- Immediately self-isolate and contact a health care provider if you exhibit any symptoms of COVID-19

Penalties

- Failure to abide by the Public Health Orders of the Chief Public Health Officer may result in:
 - Fine up to \$1500
 - Court summons
 - Apprehension
