#### Chandler Mayor Update

Smart and efficient mobility systems are essential to the success of businesses, quality of life for residents and experience of our visitors. Mobility is the ability to go places, and Chandler is committed to providing forward-thinking transportation networks connecting residents and visitors not only to destinations within Chandler but also to the greater East Valley region.

As business leaders and residents of Chandler, mobility greatly affects your everyday lives, so I am asking for your input on the future of transportation within our community. There will be two opportunities in October to provide your feedback:

- Earlier this year, the City conducted two online surveys to gauge opinions on the electric scooter ("e-scooter") and bike sharing services operating in cities across the country. A public meeting will be held at 5 p.m., Wednesday, Oct. 16, to solicit feedback on a proposed Shared Mobility Pilot Program based on the feedback from those surveys. The meeting will be held at the Chandler Museum, 300 S. Chandler Village Dr. After receiving additional input at this public meeting, City staff will present a proposal to the Chandler Transportation Commission, followed by a presentation to the City Council in early 2020. Public input will be welcome at these meetings, which will be posted on the City's public meeting calendar at chandleraz.gov/events.
- Draft plans of two transportation studies, the Chandler Transportation Master Plan 2019 Update (TMP) and the Arizona Avenue Alternatives Analysis Study, will be presented to the public during a meeting from 5-7 p.m., Thursday, Oct. 24, at Chandler Community Center, 125 E. Commonwealth Ave. The City's TMP was last updated in 2010 and since that time, the community has changed considerably, including population and employment growth, new residential and commercial development, and the introduction of autonomous vehicle technologies. Transportation needs in Chandler are evolving with the City's growth and with the changing trends in transportation and technology. Your input is a valuable and necessary component to ensuring we are planning efficiently for the future. I hope to see you at these upcoming meetings.

#### Wrap Up—Friday, September 27th 2019

The September 27th program featured Eric Anderson, Executive Director for the Maricopa Association of Governments (MAG), Matthew Contorelli, VP of Public Affairs & Rural Development for the Arizona Corporation Authority (ACA), spoke on the status of operations in economic development, transportation and diversification within Chandler and Arizona. Anderson presented the coordination among regional governments and businesses within MAG and how they are working towards stronger partnerships with international trade, reinforcement of Arizona transportation infrastructure as well the future of Prop 400, and unification of goals in Arizona's regions. Matthew Contorelli showcased the ACA's work in attracting international business, supporting established businesses and promoting projects to increase high-wage employment opportunities. We also heard from Representative Mitzi Epstein (LD 18), discussing goals in education and supporting mental health professionals, Chandler Mayor Kevin Hartke, updated the status of new budget surveys in November as well as the finalization of the new downtown parking garage, and finally, Vice Mayor Terry Roe, highlighted occasions such as Domestic Violence Awareness month.

#### The Chandler Chamber of Commerce was recently in Denver for the National U.S. Chamber of Commerce LEAD Conference.

The purpose of this conference was for Chambers across the country to come together in order to establish a cohesive set of legislative priorities that affect all businesses from the national to the local level and educate them on these issues. There were many policy issues on the agenda such as; criminal justice reform, autonomous vehicles, marijuana legalization pertaining to employers, healthcare for employers, intellectual property issues, energy, trade, infrastructure and employment law among others. All of which will impact the business community and the economy in the coming legislative session, both at the state or federal level.

The issue of data privacy could possibly have the greatest effect on business in the coming years depending on how it is legislated. California has recently passed a sweeping data privacy bill, the California Consumer Privacy Act, which potentially threatens businesses on several levels. Caveats such as fines, implementation, overly broad definitions and the scope of the legislation make the CCPA very worrisome for businesses. As the Information and Communications Technology (ITC) is deeply rooted in in the US economy, with more than 5 jobs (5.73 multiplier) tied to every one job in tech that could be affected, this issue is of paramount importance and requires well thought out and flexible legislation. Several states in the country have already followed the example of the CCPA, however, Arizona must find a path to data privacy that is unique to our needs and applied with greater prudence on all levels.

Criminal justice reform is also an issue that continues to influence the greater economy negatively and is also a work-force issue at the federal and state level, particularly here in Arizona. Representative Blackman (R) Snowflake, and Representative Toma (R) Peoria, have stated that they fully intend to introduce much needed criminal justice reform bills in the upcoming 2020 session to help address the burden the current justice system places on the for-mentioned issues.

As Chandler remains a national leader in the Autonomous Vehicle (AV) space, legislation that will affect everything from liability issues, hierarchy and uniformity of authority and regulation, to how AV's are introduced into the greater traffic flow of regular drivers, needs to be carefully considered and crafted with an exceptionally wide range of stakeholders. The Chandler Chamber of Commerce is at the forefront of the issue with stakeholders considering the policy implications. The Chamber is hosting a one-of-a-kind Autonomous Vehicle Symposium to inform and educate the public on November 14, 2019 in coordination with the larger Smart City Consortium. This will not only feature the foremost companies in this field but safety, policy and tech experts who are leading the nation/world in Autonomous Vehicle field. Demonstrations of this technology will be showcased as well, don't miss it! Click here to register.

These are just a few of the issues that the Chandler Chamber is focused on. 





security program and accelerated middle school.


