# POLICY IMPACT SERIES



#### Wrap Up—November 8th

On November 8th, the Chandler Chamber welcomed Executive Vice President of the Arizona Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Garrick Taylor, as well as State Senators J.D. Mesnard and Sean Bowie, as part of our Public Policy Impact Series, providing updates on current and possible future issues affecting Arizonans.



Executive Vice President Garrick Taylor provided insight into the state of Arizona's strong financial standing, federal laws impacting Arizona, as well as upcoming ballot initiatives that may be important in 2020. Second, Senator Mesnard commented on continued education importance, affirming the current strong economic status of the State and using the current budget surplus of Arizona to give back to the taxpayers. Senator Bowie followed by speaking on continued importance of social and emotional wellness resources, continuing efforts to boost Arizona's education, and providing a legislative outlook on issues such as vaping and short-term house rentals.

#### Wrap Up—November 22nd

The Chandler Chamber of Commerce welcomed Maricopa County District 1 Supervisor, Jack Sellers, and Maricopa County's Deputy Recorder for Communications, Kathren Coleman, to focus on preparation for upcoming elections in 2020. Supervisor Sellers updated us on several key aspects of upcoming elections, such as addressing the problems from 2016 and finalizing contingency plans for any unforeseen problems that may arise. The Supervisor also provided an update on several key transportation notes, including the completion of the South Mountain Freeway, the I-10 Broadway

Curve construction, and a proposed I-11 being in the initial phases. Then, Deputy Recorder for

Communications, Kathren Coleman went more in depth on election preparation, noting improved efforts for communicating more effectively with voters regarding their polling locations and questions. The County Recorder's office also noted improvements in efficiency and security regarding ballots to ensure a secure election process in 2020. To wrap up, several city council candidates introduced themselves to those in attendance and provided their positions headed into the upcoming year.




