

As Chandler continues to attract new and growing businesses, an important aspect of our economic development efforts are focused on building our tourism portfolio. Throughout 2019 we continued the implementation of the Tourism Strategic Plan through efforts to promote our community for meetings, events, business and leisure travel. Chandler underwent a rebrand in 2019 to reflect the direction and focus of the City's tourism efforts as a place not only to connect for business, but disconnect in their downtime and enjoy the community's amenities. The rebranding included a redesign of the tourism website and the execution of a new digital campaign, complete with a new destination video. Our Economic Development team is taking tourism to a new level in Chandler and as of third quarter 2019, hotel/motel bed tax collections are up 12% over the same period in 2018.

Over the past decade more than 2,000 rooms have been added to our community. We recently celebrated the grand opening of the Marriott Phoenix Chandler in the Price Corridor, which has the largest contiguous conference space in the community. The Price Corridor continues to grow, and with over 500 companies and 40,000 jobs, this full-service hotel will fill a big need for rooms and space in one of our largest corridors. We also recently welcomed the Extended Stay America Phoenix-Chandler Downtown hotel in December with 136 rooms in central Chandler. This hotel adds to our extended stay options for the longer-term business travelers we are attracting.

As Chandler is in the early stages of the execution of the Tourism Strategic Plan, our efforts will continue to evolve as our community grows. 2020 is going to be a remarkable year and I look forward to all of the exciting things to come. 


