SEEKING INPUT ON HIGHWAY 75 STREETSCAPE

The Highway 75 corridor serves as part of the US Highway system and acts as our main street. The City of Sioux Center is working on a design with the Iowa DOT, DGR Engineering, and Confluence that will change Highway 75 in Sioux Center to an enhanced 4-lane roadway. This concept features two lanes of travel in each direction with medians and a center turn lane.

As we plan for improvements, we want to design a corridor that will safely serve our community and visitors, promote safe use for pedestrians, and welcome travelers to our thriving community.
