The fine print:

- A. Award will be given over a 4-year period of \$1500 per year for 4 years. Applicant must remain employed by the same employer for the 4-year period in order to receive the full grant amount
- B. Applicants not receiving the award in the current year, may reapply the following year, but will be asked to resubmit all necessary paperwork. Applicants can apply a maximum of 2 times. Review committee will not retain paperwork from year to year.
- C. Review Process
 - a. Finalists will have a face-to-face or virtual interview with the Homecoming Grant Advisory Board
- D. Timeline
 - a. Application deadline is March 1
 - b. Applications reviewed and interviews completed March 1-April 15
 - c. Award announced by April 30
