

Sioux Center, IA - Farmers Coop Society and The How-To Building Center have partnered with the City of Sioux Center to provide more affordable housing in the Sioux Center Community.

The past several years seen the very real need for more affordable housing in Sioux Center and the surrounding communities. Farmers Coop Society saw an opportunity to utilize The How-To Building Center's broad range of quality materials and services they offer at the store to help address this housing shortage. Materials and products such as lumber, windows, paint, and appliances as well as design services from The How-To Building Center will be used in these homes. Farmers Coop Society is partnering with local contractors to build these homes.
