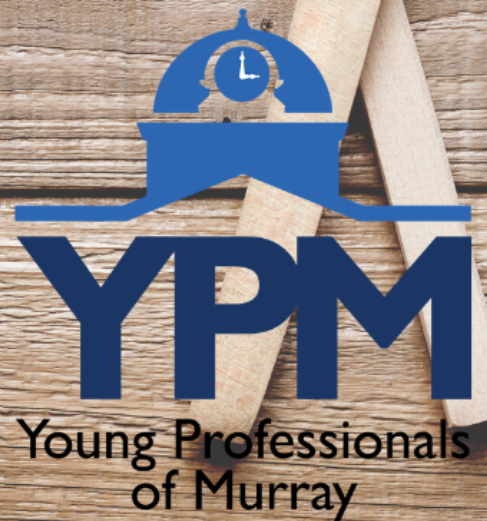

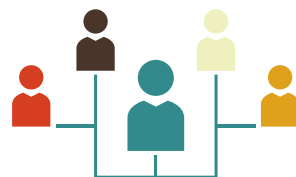
YPM COMMITTEES
