
- > Support: Support the success of existing northern Michigan businesses

2022 Work:

> Hosted the Northern Michigan Policy

Conference in January with over 175 attendees; speakers included Governor Gretchen Whitmer, U.S. Senator Garv Peters, Congressman Jack Bergmann, MEDC CEO Quentin Messer, MSHDA Director Gary Heidel, Business Leaders of Michigan Vice President Gabe Rodriguez, State Representatives Roth, O'Malley, Allor, Damoose, and Hoitenga, and State Senators Schmidt, VanderWall, and Stamas.

- > Supported the appointment of Alliancemember and Lake Superior Community Partnership CEO Sarah Lucas to serve as the Deputy for Rural Development in the new Office of Rural Development; drafted and presented budget request and office framework to advocate for continued ORD support
- > Welcomed State Treasurer Rachael Eubanks and Budget Director Chris Harkins for a zoom meeting to reinforce support for Tri-Share Childcare, Michigan Reconnect, Pure Michigan, and Going PRO; welcomed Director Harkins again in-person at North Central Michigan College to show Michigan Reconnect and Futures for Frontliners at work
- > Helped initiate a bipartisan effort in childcare reform to increase accessibility in northern Michigan by including measures to increase capacity at facilities, networks for at-home providers, operation at multi-use facilities, and a 90-day grace period to comply with new health and safety rules
- > Joined the Housing Michigan Coalition to move a package of policy bills seeking to address the lack of workforce housing across the state, aimed at incentivizing the development of workforce housing and missingmiddle housing
