

When can I get a **COVID-19 VACCINE** in NH?

DECEMBER - MARCH*

PHASE 1B **NOW OPEN**

To register go to www.vaccines.nh.gov

- People 65 and older
- Medically vulnerable people under 65 who are at significantly higher risk with 2 or more conditions
- Family caregivers of medically vulnerable persons under 16 years old
- Residents and staff of residential facilities for persons with intellectual and developmental disabilities
- Corrections officers and staff working in correctional facilities
- First responders and health workers not already vaccinated



PHASE 2A

- K-12 school and childcare staff

PHASE 2B

- People 50-64 years old

MARCH - MAY*



PHASE 3A

- Medically vulnerable people under 50 years old at moderately higher risk with 1 or more conditions

PHASE 3B

- Everyone else not already vaccinated

MAY and BEYOND*

*Estimated time frame depends on vaccine doses allocated to NH from the federal government and vaccine uptake.



For those who have already been contacted by the CDC to register for a Vaccine Administration Management System (VAMS) account – please encourage folks to check back often for more appointment availability.

Do not provide any personal payment information (credit cards). Insurance providers can be charge for administration fee – no charge for the vaccine from individuals.



COVID-19 Vaccine Access Points

1. Fixed Vaccination Site (110 Krif Rd. Keene, Keene State College Athletic Complex)
 - Staffed by amazing members of the National Guard + Public Health Network volunteers – including Cheshire + MCH current and retired staff

2. Mobile Clinics/Closed Points of Dispensing (PODs)
 - Hundred Nights Shelter

 - Ex. Cheshire County House of Corrections, CVS, Walgreens, Walmart
