EyeWorks Celebrates Grand Opening at New West Street Location

Dr. Barton Higley and his team at EyeWorks are thrilled to announce the grand opening of their new location at 166 West Street in Keene. Dr. Higley purchased the building and began construction in 2021, and the new location opened on May 31st.



Located in Keene's historic district extension, the building, totalling nearly 4,200 square feet, boasts a 700 square foot optical boutique with a 900 frame capacity, optical lab, six exam lanes, a dry eye treatment suite, and a spacious parking lot. An emphasis has been placed on the interior being aesthetically pleasing, with natural light pouring in through windows, beautiful hardwood cabinetry, live plants, and stone countertops. The EyeWorks team collaborated with local craftsmen and artisans whenever possible throughout the planning process. The exterior's natural brick finish is accompanied by a beautiful hand carved sign, both of which were designed to complement Keene's charming appeal. The overall effect is a peaceful, clean space that is pleasing to the eye as well as the mind.

"We needed room to grow and comfortably provide the best care to my patients," says Dr. Higley. "We've really been too big for the Kohl's Plaza location for a few years now. When this location became available for purchase, I couldn't pass up the opportunity to reinvest into our local community. My intent has always been

to return to the area I grew up in, own a business, and hopefully inspire others to do the same."

In addition to the new building, patients will notice a change



to the EyeWorks logo. The new logo boasts bright colors and a series of circles reminiscent of the phoropter that optometrists use to prescribe glasses. "I wanted a logo that better expressed my excitement for this field of work and what I do every day. I think that comes through in the vibrant colors and the nod to optometric equipment," says Dr. Higley.

Dr. Higley says that he can't take all of the credit for the new building, "Not a day goes by that I don't feel gratitude for this community, my outstanding team, and the patients who believe in EyeWorks. They are the real catalyst for this growth."



Yankee Publishing, Inc., a longstanding, family-owned business, recently transitioned to 100% employee ownership through the sale of stock to the company's Employee Stock Ownership Plan (ESOP).

Family shareholders had previously sold a minority interest to its ESOP and, on June 30, 2022, the ESOP purchased the remaining shares outstanding.

As the publisher of Yankee, The Old Farmer's Almanac, New Hampshire Magazine and Family Tree Magazine, Yankee Publishing (YPI) has roots in traditional print publishing. Over the last 25 years, it has expanded substantially into the digital arena and into preparing custom content for its clients.

"The family felt strongly that the company needs to remain independent, not be sold to another business that might not care for our brands," said **Jamie Trowbridge**, YPI's CEO. "This is a time of transition in the media industries, and we think the company's employee-owners will be the best stewards of the business."

Founded in 1935, the company grew slowly and steadily. Central to its success – then and now – was the acquisition of The Old Farmer's Almanac, which provided the company with a national footprint.

When the digital world collided with the traditional publishing world in the 1990s, YPI resolved to remain independent and embraced the Internet as a publishing platform. Trowbridge took over as CEO in 1999 and led the company through many changes to position it for success in the 21st century.

In 2012, YPI acquired McLean Communications, the publisher of New Hampshire Magazine, as a way of growing its media footprint within New England and diversifying the media businesses it owns. In 2019, YPI acquired Family Tree, the premier magazine about genealogy in the U.S.

"As a 100% employee-owned company, we are more excited than ever about what the future holds in store for Yankee Publishing," Trowbridge said.

Cheshire Medical Center, a member of Dartmouth Health, is pleased to announce that KrisEmily McCrory, MD, MS Med Ed, FAAFP, has been hired as a faculty member and associate program director for the planned Cheshire Medical Center Family Medicine Residency

program. The opportunity to add a Family Medicine Residency program at Cheshire comes at a time when community health needs make it critically important to train more family physicians.

"Having grown up in New England, I am excited to return to the area and help establish a family medicine residency in Keene. I hope to bring my enthusiasm



and experience to this role, working with a great team to help educate new generations of family physicians," said Dr. McCrory. The Family Medicine Residency program clinic will be located at 62 Maple Avenue, the former Peerless Insurance property. The residency program will apply to the Accreditation Council for Graduate Medical Education (ACGME) later this year, with plans for program accreditation in the spring of 2023.

Faculty physicians, including Dr. McCrory and Program Director Dr. Karl Dietrich, and residents will provide full-spectrum care to their patients at Maple Avenue and in the hospital. Plans call for 18 residents, with the first class of six residents starting in July 2024. The residents will add a new dimension to care and with a diverse set of knowledge and experiences as they continue their training and prepare to become independent providers.

Prior to coming to Cheshire, Dr. McCrory spent the past year as a private practice physician at Delmar Family Medicine in Slingerlands, NY. Before that, she spent eight years as core faculty at the Ellis Family Medicine Residency in Schenectady, NY, where she spearheaded multiple women's health initiatives and provided full-spectrum clinical services. The New York State Academy of Family Physicians recognized her as their Family Medicine Educator of the Year in 2019.
