Dr. Sowick recently completed his emergency medicine residency at Temple University Hospital in Philadelphia, where he has been serving as



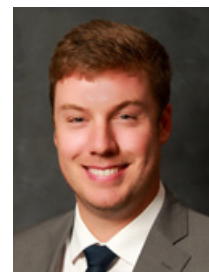
a resident physician for the past several years.
