What is a Chamber of Commerce Ambassador?

As a Chamber of Commerce Ambassador, you are a front line representative for the Christian County Chamber of Commerce at public and Chamber sponsored events/activities such as Business After Hours, Eye Opener Breakfasts, Ribbon Cuttings, Grand Openings, and Groundbreakings. You will assist in welcoming, connecting, and engaging past and present members. As an Ambassador, your dedication, time and efforts are appreciated and highly valued by the Board of Directors, Chamber Staff, and Membership during your one-year term. You **ARE** the backbone of the Christian County Chamber of Commerce.

Why should I be a Chamber Ambassador?

As a Chamber Ambassador, you will gain increased business exposure and professional career development, as well as gain business opportunities through your association with other volunteers and increased visibility for you and your business within the community.

What are the EXPECTATIONS and REQUIREMENTS?

All Ambassadors should plan to do the following:

- Attend no less than 9 monthly meetings. (*Meetings are held on the 2nd Thursday of each month at 12:00 PM at the Commerce Center in the upstairs meeting room unless otherwise notified.*)
- Encourage assigned courtesy contacts to participate in additional activities that promote the Chamber (*i.e. Eye Opener Breakfasts, Business After Hours, Ribbon Cuttings, Chili Cook-Off, Veterans Day Parade, etc.*)
- Attend monthly Business After Hours
- Attend at least 1/3 of Scheduled Ribbon Cuttings
- Recruit prospective members
- Represent the Chamber in a professional manner
- Serve as the host/hostess for Chamber events
- Willing to welcome, encourage, and contact assigned members through personal visits, phone calls, or mail and communicate information on benefits and Chamber events.

Monthly Meetings:

Meetings are held on the 2nd Thursday of each month at 12:00 PM at the Commerce Center in the upstairs meeting room unless otherwise notified.

Ambassadors are encouraged to bring potential members and guest to monthly meetings.

If you are unable to attend a meeting, it is your responsibility to notify Robin Tabor at the Chamber, by cell (270) 963.2573, or by email rtabor@christiancountychamber.com by 3:00 PM the Tuesday before the meeting.

At every meeting, each Ambassador will be expected to give a report on their assigned monthly courtesy contacts.

There will be a sign-in sheet at each meeting; it is your responsibility to sign-in as this is one way we will keep record of those who attend.

Please note that your application will not be considered complete until the \$48 (*semi-annual*) meal fee is submitted.
