



ROUND 2: PAYCHECK PROTECTION

The U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA), in consultation with the Treasury Department, announced the Paycheck Protection Program (PPP) would re-open the week of January 11 for new borrowers and certain existing PPP borrowers. To promote access to capital, initially only community financial institutions were able to make First Draw PPP Loans on Monday, January 11, and Second Draw PPP Loans on Wednesday, January 13. The PPP is now open to all participating lenders.

Key PPP updates include:

- PPP borrowers can set their PPP loan's covered period to be any length between 8 and 24 weeks to best meet their business needs
- PPP loans will cover additional expenses, including operations expenditures, property damage costs, supplier costs, and worker protection expenditures
- The Program's eligibility is expanded to include 501(c) (6)s, housing cooperatives, destination marketing organizations, among other types of organizations
- The PPP provides greater flexibility for seasonal employees
- Certain existing PPP borrowers can request to modify

their First Draw PPP Loan amount

• Certain existing PPP borrowers are now eligible to apply for a Second Draw PPP Loan.

A borrower is generally eligible for a Second Draw PPP Loan if the borrower:

- Previously received a First Draw PPP Loan and will or has used the full amount only for authorized uses;
- Has no more than 300 employees; and
- Can demonstrate at least a 25% reduction in gross receipts between comparable quarters in 2019 and 2020.

We encourage small business owners to take advantage of the SBA Emergency Loan Webinar Series every Thursday in Feburary from 9 to 10 a.m. to ask questions and learn more about applying for PPP/EIDL. To register, visit PASBDC.org or call 717-477-1935.

COMMUNITY LEADERSHIP

Government leadership, law enforcement and the criminal justice system in Franklin County were the January 2021 session topics for Leadership Franklin County (LFC) Community. The morning virtual session gave students the opportunity to learn more about how local government functions, current issues facing state and local officials and the election process in our community. The distinguished faculty included: Waynesboro Borough Council Member Pat Fleagle, Waynesboro School Board President Karen Herald, Franklin County Commissioner Chairman David Keller and Alice Elia, Chambersburg Borough Council. The interactive panel finished the morning by breaking into small groups for more in-depth Q&A with the class. Jarred Knott of Orrstown Bank and the LFCC Steering Committee facilitated the morning session. Knott also serves as a Borough Council Member in Waynesboro.

Dr. Kim Eaton, Franklin County Director of Reentry & Clinical Quality Assurance who also serves as co-chair of Franklin Together Reentry Coalition, led the afternoon virtual session. Dr. Eaton and guest speakers reviewed the local law enforcement and criminal justice system in the county, overviewed the county jail, corrections and probation process and talked about the economic impact to our county budget. The day finished with an interactive exercise where students assumed one of nine roles of incarcerated individuals – the mini simulation was a great opportunity for students to experience the challenges previously incarcerated individuals face when assimilating back into the community.

The exercise exposed students to the criminal justice system in Franklin County in a new way to help them learn more about the services involved beyond what they normally see, as well as educate them on collateral consequences of criminal records. Students were able to sensitize to the realities of difficult situations for re-entering citizens and better understand real issues and barriers to self-sufficiency.



LFC YOUTH CLASS ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS

Eligible students are current ninth grade students attending any Franklin County school (public, private or home school) who will be sophomores during the 2021-2022 school year. Students started that planning in their January session and hope to have the group video ready for release on social media by mid-March. The class has met the challenge of building relationships virtually this year and continue to represent their home schools while showing their ability to adjust, change and learn from this unusual learning environment.
